CATEGORICALLY ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS LIST

For Tier 2 Family Day Care Home Providers Participating in CACFP:

- Food Assistance Program (FAP) 7 CFR 226.13(e)(i)
- Family Independence Program (FIP) 7CFR 226.13(e)(i)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) 7CFR 226.13(e)(i)
- Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) (Income Levels 185%)
- All Head Start Participants – Income levels more stringent than CACFP (Income Levels more stringent than CACFP in 2015) (Even Start has been defunded in Michigan and no longer qualifies)
- The Emergency Food Assistance Program Nation (TEFAP) (Income levels- 185%)
- National School Lunch and School Breakfast Program (Eligible for free or reduced-price meals based on NSLP Income Eligibility Statement (IES). However, if a district is participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), individual IES must be completed for CACFP)
